After the nearly ideal establishment conditions of early As with most responsible companies, CYO Seeds Autumn 2023, things rapidly went pear shaped as the weather closed in and stopped just about all the field work by mid-ish November. With the continuing horrible weather through to mid January, this means there's still a huge area to plant up and a quite a lot that needs re-drilling. However, one thing to remember is, check out the last drilling dates for any Winter seed you may have in stock from last Autumn before opting for Spring seed. A late drilled Winter crop will often out do a Spring one.

# MORE "FARM SAVED SEED (FSS)"

Last year's bought in seed prices were high but they seem cheap compared to this Springs prices! To be fair this isn't all due to profiteering! A lot of the cost is because it's having to be imported because the UK hasn't got enough to meet the demand. It's no surprise then, farmers are choosing to increase the amount of FSS they do and others are doing it for the first time. They can then look forward to huge cost savings, having greater control over seed quality and enjoy the general flexibility of doing FSS. You can save your seed again and again, it hasn't got to come from new C1 or C2 seed every year. Please remember, bought in seed that's sold as a "new variety" is at least 10 generations (years) old when you buy it for the first time as "new seed"! More established varieties are much older. The wheel was only invented once...


# **<u>COMPARATIVE</u>** SPECIES POPULARITY AUTUMNS 2019 - 2023 This is the seed processed by CYO and converted into hectares to show relative land use



Looking at the the above figures for Autumn 2023 it's all change again. How much of the changes are purely weather related remains to be seen. We'll have a better idea after our Spring processing season. Wheat area is back to where it normally is. Rape and Bean areas are down significantly as farmers are reacting to fluctuating quality and yields issues. It's no surprise that the barley area's up. However, more interestingly, our second most popular variety is a Spring one.

Looking at the graphs below you'll see that **KWS Extase** has retained the top spot for **wheat** varieties for the third year running. However, **KWS Dawsum** another high yielding all rounder has come from nowhere to claim second place. **Crusoe** has overtaken **Graham** and **Skyfall** to claim third. The **Oil seed rape** list is dominated again by **Acacia** with **Campus** and **Flamingo** pushing **Aspire** down to fourth place. **Winter Barley's** front runner is **KWS Tardis**, whilst **Bolton** and **Explorer** have pushed **KWS Orwell** back down the list. The **Beans** area is topped by **Tundra** again but **Vespa** has gained a lot of popularity this year and could be a challenger next Autumn. **Oats** are just oats, but with **Canyon** and **WPB Isabel** it's no longer a one horse race for **Mascani**. *No prizes for figuring out that the main farmer focus is very much on yield potential, disease profile and overall quality*.
